

# APA Citation Guide to Make an Annotated Bibliography that Works

These bibliographies always used to make me tense. Always.

But now I have written them enough times that I know there is absolutely nothing to worry about. Nothing.

This is exactly what I want you to know. You are probably tempted to look for a [expert essay writer online](#) and personally, I see nothing wrong with it. But before that, have a look at this guide I have made for you.

This is for an APA-style bibliography, complete with annotations.

Once you have the basics down by studying the article, then you can move to those writing services.

So, have a look.

## Step #1: An APA Cover Page

In the case of APA, we have to make a title page. This includes the most basic information about yourself and your institution.

Your professor will actually tell you which information to place here [essay writing](#).

Just remember that this information will be placed in the middle of the page. Totally in the middle.

So, center your cursor and begin.

## Step #2: Scratch the Abstract

When we write in APA style, we include an abstract too. But for an [paper writing service](#), that is not necessary. Actually, an abstract would be useless here. So, no need to place one or write one.

But just in case you are asked to write one, know that it is a summary of the contents of your paper.

## Step #3: Study an APA Reference

The only way to write an APA reference is to study one. You can find plenty of examples online. But, I will give you one here.

There. Now, you know what an APA reference looks like.

#### **Step #4: Set the Page**

You will need to set the page according to APA standards now.

Do the basics. Set margins at 1 inch. Select the font and make sure to select a readable one like Times New Roman or Arial.

The font should be 12 and the page should be double spaced. Don't set any extra space between the multiple entries [need someone to write my essay](#).

#### **Step #5: Indents and Numbering**

Note one thing. You will first enter the reference and then press enter.

When your cursor is in the next line, you will give a 0.5-inch indent and then start typing your annotation. You can do this by simply pressing the "TAB" key.

Also, number the pages. Place the page number on the top right corner.

#### **Step #6: The Annotation Itself**

When it comes to the annotation, note that the reference is written in bold but the annotation is not.

Also, the annotation does not have a word limit but the average word count is 150 words.

But this also depends on your professor. They can tell you to write an annotation in 100 words or even 200.

## **Step #7: Check the Order and Revise**

In APA, the references are sorted in alphabetical order.

So, after you are done writing, look over your bibliography and sort it out accordingly [my essay writer](#).

Then go ahead and read the bibliography to make sure you have not made a mistake. Look over at the references very carefully.

Check for grammar, punctuation, and the usual stuff, and your bibliography is ready [i need someone to write my essay for me](#).
