Interesting Facts About MLA 8th Edition

1. Similar standards citation format for every kind of source

In the previous editions, writers were needed to put a certain citation format for each source that they have used in their work. However, it is become impracticable to make a citation format for all kinds of sources. Because the data is now received in various ways ranging from books and papers to social media posts. Hence, in the 8th edition, now one and similar citation format would be used for creating citations.

2. **Insertion of Links or URLs**

In the last edition of MLA, including Links or URLs of the source being used was left to the instructor. In other words, it was the instructors' choice to require students to put Links or URLs in the citation. However, in the new edition, it is hugely suggested to put a link or URL of every source that the writer has used in the work.

Due to this change in the MLA format, every [paper writing service](#) requires their writers to include links/URLs in citations.

In addition to this, this change is an interesting one because it allows the checker/instructor to trace the info only using the link or URL. This also helps to know if the work is outdated'.

3. **Omitting the city of the source publication**

It was mandatory for the [essay writer](#) or authors (in the previous editions of MLA formats) to include the region or city where the work has been published. However, it cannot be denied that such details serve little and a minor purpose. Due to this fact, the Modern Language Association (MLA) has decided to allow the writers or authors to omit the city of publication.

However, you can still include it if you think it is needed. You can also do so if your instructor requires you to do.

Moreover, based on changes brought by MLA in its 8th edition, you will need to put the city of publication only if the source's version varies from the place, it has been published.

4. **Using a fiction name for the name of the author**

In the previous MLA format, writers [write my paper for me](#) or authors of work were required to use the only name of the author in the citation. However, the 8th edition has made things much easier. This means the writer (i.e., a student) can now use screen names or an online handle in place of the author's name.

In simple words, it is now acceptable as per guidelines of MLA 8th edition to use pseudonyms for authors' names.
