Process of Writing a Thesis

Thesis writing usually progresses according to the following steps:

1. Research Topic

2. **Review Existing Literature**

3. **Research Proposal**

4. **Organization of the Thesis**

A general structure of the thesis is always the same regardless of the topic and the subject area. It includes the following contents:

- Cover page
- Abstract
- Table of contents
- Introduction
- Theoretical framework
- Methodology
- Data analysis
- Findings
- List of references

5. **Writing Techniques**

The writer should know the basics of formal academic writing techniques. It also requires an in-depth knowledge of the correct language and grammar. Vague terms should be avoided. Tables and figures can also be a part of quantitative research.
